First Payday of the 2019-20 School Year - Monday, September 30

Start a good habit and verify the accuracy of your paycheck each month.

Before placing that phone call or sending an email, read the following information:

- View current salary placements in **Employee Access** under "Lane/Step History"
- New hire placement and education advancement credits for movement on the salary schedule will be processed in October or November and pay will be retroactive to the beginning of the school year.
- Updated salary placements will be in Employee Access after November 30.
- Super contracts will be paid starting in October and paid over 11 months.
- Activity stipends will be paid starting in November and paid over 10 months.
- Time card, extra hours and sub pay is paid through the 10th of each month.
- The September paycheck reflects extra hours worked Aug 11-Sept 10.


