### More About SEBB

Do not wait to begin your SEBB benefits enrollment.

#### Did you know?

Your enrollment application stays live until Nov. 15? You can back in and make changes/finish enrollment at any time prior to the Nov. 15 deadline.

SEBB is a <u>state mandated change</u> to your benefits. The district can no longer negotiate benefits for employees.

If you do not enroll or opt-out to waive your medical coverage, you will be defaulted into the Uniform Medical Plan Achieve 1 and this will be your <u>primary</u> medical coverage.

Everyone enrolling in a medical plan is considered a smoker unless you elect to be a non-smoker during your enrollment.

Delta Care and Willamette Dental are managed care plans. Uniform Dental (managed by Delta Dental) is a PPO plan.

The HCA will be holding an in-person benefits fair on October 14 at Bellevue College from 4:00-8:00PM

American Fidelity has added more appointments to assist you with your SEBB benefits enrollment and Dependent Verification Attestation.

The LWSD, LWEA and WEA continue to work very hard to bring you accurate and concise information as changes, even within the last few weeks, have been implemented by SEBB.

As new information/changes are revealed by SEBB, the LWEA will continue to collaborate with LWSD to find solutions for our members.


