LWEA and LWSD are still working on an FAQ regarding the new PFML law. However, if you had a child in the last year and are interested in taking time in 2020 for a child you had in 2019- please call the PFML hotline number to see if you qualify for PFML. Hotline number: (833)717-2273.

Here is what we know at this point:

- You need to give the district 30 days' notice if you are taking this benefit.
- The state sets the qualifications and you need to apply through the state. Check the links for more information.
- The benefit for PFML is 90% of your salary or \$1000 a week. The maximum benefit you can receive is \$1000 a week.
- It is your choice on whether or not you use sick leave while also receiving PFML benefits, (this is how our short term disability insurance operated in the past). But if you opt to take sick leave while getting the PFML benefit it must be taken in increments of zero, half day, or full day.
- The district agreed to pay the employee share **and** the employer share of PFML for 2020. In January 2021 we will begin dividing the cost of PFML between the individual employee and the employer. We will be reviewing this in bargaining during the spring of 2021.

SEBB Benefits Transition and Reminders

Current benefit plans will expire on December 31, 2019 and SEBB Benefits will go into effect starting on January 1, 2020. Here are a few reminders and things to be aware of during this transition:

- Vision Benefits: Make sure to utilize your current NBN Vision benefits by December 31, 2019. Your current plan entitles you and your dependents to an eye exam and glasses (or contacts in lieu of) once every 365 days, paid in full. You can review your NBN Vision benefit status by visiting www.nwadmin.com.
- **Prescriptions:** Submit or refill any Rx Prescriptions by December 31, 2019 to avoid any potential issues during the transition to SEBB benefits.
- **Benefits Cards:** Medical, Dental, and Vision benefit cards will be mailed to your home address by December 31, 2019. If you do not receive your benefit card by December 31, 2019, you should contact the benefit plan that you selected directly. Contact information for each benefit plan is available on pages 2 & 3 of the <u>Benefits Enrollment Guide</u>. If you selected the UMP Dental plan, you will receive a welcome letter with your ID number instead of an ID card.
- **Medical Premium Shift:** Due to the change to SEBB, medical premium payments are shifting from being collected a month in advance and will instead be collected during the month of the benefit coverage. This means that you will <u>not</u> have a medical premium deduction on your December paycheck because your November paycheck paid for coverage through December 31. The first premium deduction for SEBB insurance will be on your January paycheck.
