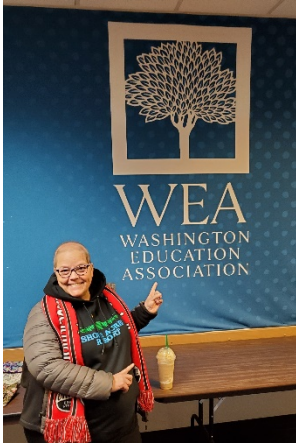


Spokane UniServ Council Director to the Board Nominees
