Subject: Update - In-Person for Fall

Good afternoon and happy Friday,

We wanted to provide an update on in-person learning for early grades after further review of the recent intent to enroll, capacity, and staffing data. Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we continue to dial in what is safely possible based on numerous factors and pieces of information.

Approximately 74% of families currently intend for their students to attend school in-person in the fall. Based on this and other data points, the decision has been made that PreK and Kindergarten (not first grade) will be in-person 4-5 days per week in the fall, for families that select that option.

We will provide more detailed information and data over the upcoming weeks, but we wanted to provide this brief and critical update as soon as we could.
