Highlights of WEA BOD Actions (July 2020-Present)

Racial & Social Justice

- HISTORIC ACTION! We approved a <u>NEW CENTER within WEA</u> called the Racial, Social and Economic Justice Center with the charge of advancing racial and economic justice in our public education system. This entails hiring new staff and strengthening Equity Teams in Locals and Councils around the state. More info coming soon!
- Every WEA department and work team reported how they share the responsibility to focus on Racial Justice. Just ask if you'd like to read those documents!
- Your Rainier Uniserv Council's Equity Team, or RECN, has been recognized as a leader in the nation for its work and will continue to be instrumental in identifying and combating institutional racism in our society. For more info and to attend RECN's next event, <u>click here.</u>

Representative Assembly Updates

- New Business Items (NBIs) submitted for consideration by the WEA Representative Assembly (which
 was cancelled for Spring 2020) underwent review by the BOD and quite a few were passed. <u>Here is a

- The BOD voted to make WEA Rep Assembly virtual in 2021. Check with your local Association for how to run for delegate to the RA!

Issues and Resolutions

- Resolutions that were passed by the BOD include:
 - Community Relief COVID Funds
 - Solidarity with BLM,
 - <u>WEA Support for Locals Who Participate in Nationwide General Strike to Ensure Peaceful</u> <u>Transition of Presidency</u>,
 - Indigenous Peoples to Develop Land Acknowledgments
 - Call to Action for Missing Indigenous Women
 - Columbus Day replaced with Indigenous Peoples' Day
- We tracked the statewide elections closely and are pleased that we maintained Chris Reykdal as Superintendent of Public Instruction and are glad that our contribution of \$150,000 to the YES on R-90 campaign kept the historic Sex-Ed bill passed by the legislature in 2020 in place. - The BOD adopted the Aspiring Educators Program (aka SWEA) operating procedures to fully include aspiring educators within WEA
- WEA joined other labor partners in calling for a closure of the NW Detention Center in Tacoma.
