Submit Professional Funds NOW!!

Submitting your Professional Fund packet early allows time for Accounting to review and resolve issues prior to the end of school year. **DO NOT** contact Accounting to confirm receipt of your PF packet. You will be contacted **ONLY** if there are issues with your submission.

What you need:

- Most of your Professional Fund questions can be answered by reading your Professional Fund form and reviewing the district <u>PF Q&A LWSD</u>
- Guidelines, allowable expenses, and unallowable expenses can be found on the <u>Prof Fund</u> <u>Reimbursement Form - LWSD</u>
- If after review you still have questions, please send to askprofessionalfund@lwsd.org

Allowable Expenses:

- Home internet, you can claim \$50/month. It does not matter if bundled amount is more or less.
- Cell phone data, you can claim \$41.67/month. It does not matter if bundles amount is more or less.
- Union dues, simply complete the LWEA Dues Receipt <u>LWEA Dues Receipt</u>
- Allowable expenses, and unallowable expenses can be found on the <u>Prof Fund Reimbursement</u> <u>Form - LWSD</u>

Options for Submitting PF Packets:

- Send completed packets to LWSD Accounting Dept (located at the RC) through inter-district mail
- Mail to LWSD Accounting Dept., PO Box 97039, Redmond WA, 98073-9739.
- Deliver to the LWEA office box located outside office door (New Location)

 - Send email to <u>Terri</u> if you drop off packet
- **DO NOT** hand deliver to RC
- Electronic copies will not be accepted





So, you're not able to pass daily attestation. Now what?

You won't pass attestation if:

- you are symptomatic.
- you test positive for COVID.
- you are a close contact of a person with a confirmed case of COVID.
- you live with someone who is symptomatic, being tested for COVID, or has a confirmed case of COVID.

Daily attestation is an important strategy for controlling the spread of COVID in our schools. Anyone who <u>cannot pass attestation</u> won't be able to enter an LWSD facility until they complete "Return to School" protocols (including a period of quarantine or isolation) and are cleared for return by the school nurse. Currently, being vaccinated does not change the attestation process for anyone. COVID is still circulating in our communities, and staff may find themselves unable to pass attestation at some point this year.

We have negotiated leave options for certificated staff specifically for situations related to COVID,

including quarantine/isolation and vaccination days.

What you should know about COVID related leave options

If you used your sick leave to cover a COVID absence, you can recover that time. If you are required to isolate or quarantine for any reason, you can work from home. If you are unable to work remotely, you have access to Emergency Health Leave.

Vaccination appointments: your leave is covered by the district.

Vaccination side effects: 1 day of leave is covered by the district.

We can help ensure that you have access to these negotiated leaves.

Children's Mental Health

In March Governor Inslee declared a <u>children's mental health emergency</u> which compelled school districts to offer more hours of in-person schooling to provide and support behavioral and mental health needs of youth across Washington state.

Due to the Governor's proclamation, the District became interested in counselors being physically present in buildings when students were in-person. Through negotiations, LWSD and LWEA reached a compromise: The minimum required in-person time will reflect the percentage of the student population that has returned to the building. This is the only change to the <u>original Counselor LOU</u>. Counselors maintain the choice of being in-person more than the minimum per their own professional judgement.
