Did you know that our CBA requires some decisions be revisited

by staff every year?

In accordance with our CBA, staff should review certain practices and procedures <u>every year</u>. These annual reviews are a best practice and ensure that LWEA and LWSD live up to the principles and mutual interests described in the <u>Trust Agreement</u>.

These annual reviews allow all staff to be heard in the decision-making process and provide an opportunity to change practices and procedures to meet the needs of the school or program. **It is especially crucial this year, with sub shortages at many schools, that these reviews are conducted according to our negotiated agreements.** Many of these items are building-based reviews to be conducted collaboratively by building educators and admin. Some items* are program-based reviews. We have linked the related CBA language in the table below.

Performing arts classes (and extra-curriculars) have specific safety requirements related to Covid. You can read the details in the DOH K-12 Schools Guidance for 21-22. Essential requirements include:

Universal masking with 3-layer medical face masks

by those participating in performing arts activities, which includes singing in general music and elementary classrooms, speech/debate, and theatre performers. <u>Cloth masks are not sufficient</u> in these situations.

Use of bell covers

while performing by aerosol-producing musicians. Masks are also recommended for use by musicians when performing. Please read the DOH guidance for details.

Additional measures

Good hygiene, reducing shared equipment, maximizing ventilation, and distancing to the greatest degree possible of at least 3 feet.

If you teach a performing arts class, or extra-curricular, please ensure that you understand the safety requirements and have the PPE you need to keep everyone safe. This week music/performing arts PPE supplies were replenished at all schools. Performing arts teachers should understand, either through their Site supervisor and/or PPE supervisor, the plan to distribute this PPE to their classrooms.
