
Q2 What is your job classification?

Q3 Do you work in a low, medium, or high transmission risk environment (as defined by Labor & Industries here)?





Q4 Which of the following mitigation measures do you feel has the most positive impact on your health and safety at work? Rank the following in the order from most to least impact.






