

# Proposed Amendment to SEA Bylaws

- 5.54 All votes on new business items at the Representative Assembly shall be decided by a simple majority.

## NEW Section 6.5 QUORUM FOR WORK STOPPAGE ACTION

- 6.51 A General Assembly of the general membership is not required for a vote on a work stoppage action. Voting on such action may be completed by the general membership by either voting at each building or electronically as decided by the Representative Assembly.
- 6.51a. The general membership vote shall consist of at least twenty percent of the Association membership representing sixty percent of the schools and work locations.
- 6.51b. Quorum for Work Stoppage Vote: Twenty percent of each bargaining unit must vote for passage of a work stoppage action.
- 6.51c. A simple majority of the votes cast will be required to pass the work stoppage action.
