We are approaching the end of the year, which means finalizing some items while planning for next year.

Elections for LWEA and Building Reps

Be sure to enact an election in your building for building reps prior to the end of the school year. Contact LWEA leadership with questions or for assistance.

For Individual members

Overage/Remedy Count Dates

Count dates occur on February 1 and April 1. Staff should double check with administrators that they are receiving appropriate remedy pay. <u>Article 13</u>

Online School Student Transfers

In-person teachers who have received OLS students transferred into their class are paid one hour (TC rate) for each incoming student. Also, if the transferred student(s) put a teacher into overage, they should receive Feb. 1 or April 1 remedy pay retroactively. LOU

Building-based Student Discipline

Principals will meet with staffs annually to review and/or make recommendations regarding building disciplinary standards and procedures to ensure uniform understanding and enforcement. 18.3
