In accordance with our Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), staff should review certain practices and procedures every year. These annual reviews are a best practice and ensure that LWEA and LWSD live up to the principles and mutual interests described in the Trust Agreement.

These annual reviews allow all staff to be heard in the decision-making process and provide an opportunity to change practices and procedures to meet the current needs of the school or program. Many of these items are building-based reviews to be conducted collaboratively by building educators and admin. Some items* are program-based reviews. Public Service Loan Forgiveness - October 31st Deadline

On October 6, 2021, the Department of Education announced a change to the Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) program rules for a limited time that allows you to get credit for payments you've made on loans that wouldn't normally qualify for PSLF. This opportunity ends on Oct. 31, 2022. Find out more about this program by visiting the Department of Education's Federal Student Aid website.

Vacation, Discretionary/Personal Emergency and Sick Leave Balances

Per employee labor agreements, emergency leave is deducted from sick leave balances. Emergency leave taken in 2021-22 will be zeroed out and applied to sick leave balances. Throughout the 2022-23 school year, employees need to remember that any use of emergency leave during the current school year will show as a negative balance in Employee Access. That balance must be deducted from sick leave to correctly determine your sick leave balance.

Year-end balances will be adjusted in September if leave balances are over the maximum allowed per employee labor agreements or the law. Frontload accruals for the 2022-2023 school year will not appear in your leave balances until late

September. Leave taken prior to frontload will be deducted after frontload occurs.
