LWEA is committed to educating our members about high-fee 403b plans. This is the time of year when people, calling themselves "Financial Professionals," may be coming into your building or emailing you to discuss your retirement benefits.

While you are eating free pizza in the staff lounge, these salespeople will tell you how your retirement plan in WA works. They may also tell you that you will not have enough savings for retirement, and they will encourage you to start saving in a 403b plan that their company offers. What they may not tell you is that signing a contract with them will enroll you in a high-fee 403b plan. They may also use this meeting to attempt to sell you life insurance or long-term care insurance with their company. Their most egregious act is encouraging you to consolidate previous retirement savings accounts into their high-fee company. They may also tell you how many of your colleagues have already opened a 403b plan to make you feel more comfortable signing up with their company.

Please be aware that the WA Department of Retirement Services does not make building visits. If you have recently received an email (possibly forwarded from your office manager or building admin) telling you that a retirement benefit provider is coming to educate staff about their retirement options, please be aware that these are salespeople using your retirement benefits as a platform to sell you their high-fee products.

### 22-23 Dues Rates for LWEA

The LWEA Bylaws require that local dues are calculated based on .007 of the prior year's total compensation for a beginning teacher. As the beginning teacher salary changes, our dues also change. In 2021-22 a beginning teacher's compensation was \$64,046. When you look at your paycheck, you'll probably notice that your dues went up this year by about \$3-\$5 dollars.

Dues are deducted in 12 monthly installments from September through August. Here's the breakdown that explains how your dues are distributed.

#### Key

- NEA: National level affiliation
- WEA: State-based affiliation and support (Prof Dev, conferences, grant programs)
- LWEA: President and VP Release Time, Bargaining, Comp Teams and Operating Expenses
- UniServ: WEA Staff Salaries and Benefits and Operating Expenses (lease, supplies, etc)
- BIPOC: Special assessment funds for BIPOC programs
- Community Outreach: Support for community groups, member engagement and grassroot lobbying.

In addition to regular dues, members may elect to participate in WEA-PAC, the state political action fund, and NEAFCPE, the national political action fund.

Pro-Education, Pro-labor.

If you elect to participate in these political action funds, your dues deduction will increase by \$2.25 per month for WEA-PAC and by \$1 per month for NEAFCPE.In large part, WEA-PAC and NEAFCPE fund opportunities for our educators to meet with legislators to share their knowledge of and expertise in the education legislation under consideration by state and federal government.
