Changes Coming to PFML Premiums

Paid Family Medical Leave (PFML) will see a rate increase starting on January 1, 2023. This represents a 0.2% increase from 2022 and a doubling of the rate from the inception of the program. This rate gets split under the law between the employer (27.4%) and employee (72.76%) for payment.

Paid Family and Medical Leave is an insurance program funded through premiums paid by nearly everyone working in Washington and many of their employers. There is now a PMFL Ombuds office available to help members who are trying to navigate the system. https://paidleaveombuds.wa.gov/
