Changes you can make during Open Enrollm

- Change your medical, dental, or vision plan
- Add or remove a dependents
- Waive medical coverage
- Enroll in medical coverage if previously waived
- Enroll or reenroll in a Medical Flexible Spending Arrangement (FSA) or the Dependent Care Assistance Program (DCAP)

How to make changes: Log in to <u>SEBB My Account</u> and submit your changes between October 31 and November 21, 2022.

2023 Flex Spending (FSA) and Dependent Care Assistance (DCAP)

FSAs allow you to set aside pretax money from your paycheck to pay for out-of-pocket health care costs. DCAP allows you to also set aside pretax money from your paycheck to pay for qualifying childcare or elder care expenses.

If you want to participate in the FSA or DCAP program for 2023, you must enroll during open enrollment even if you are currently enrolled and are not changing your contribution amounts.

MONEY MINUTE

KNOW YOUR RETIREMENT PLAN!

If you have Plan 3 as your retirement plan with the Washington Department of Retirement Systems, do you know what rate you are contributing each month to your Plan 3? You can find out in one of two ways:

- Look at your most recent LWSD paycheck on the lower left corner where the DEDUCTIONS are listed. Take the amount listed under TRS Plan 3 and divide it by your gross wages for the month listed at the top of your paycheck. If this number = 0.05, that means that you are contributing 5% of your gross wages to your Plan 3 account. If this number = 0.085, that means you are contributing 8.5% of your gross wages. The percentage that you chose when you started employment with LWSD cannot be changed unless you switch employers
- Go to the Department of Retirement Systems website <u>here</u>, click on Member Log in at the top right corner of the page and log in. On the Welcome page, you will see Teacher's Retirement System Plan 3 under Your Retirement Plan(s). Click on that link. Under Account Balance, your Current Contribution Rate is listed as a percentage.


