

CEA's New Agreement with CSD

Camas Education Association & Camas School District have come to an agreement on a 2-year contract:

Class sizes

Elementary Class Sizes

- Reduces number of students per class
- To discourage oversize classes, overload pay escalates for each student above the class size
 - o If 1 over class size, \$10 per student per day
 - o If 2 over class size, \$10 per student per day or 2 hours of paraeducator support per day
 - o If 3 over class size, \$15 per student per day or 3 hours of paraeducator support per day

Secondary Class Sizes

- Shifts from "average class size" to having baseline and maximum sizes for each class
- Mandatory creation of new class section in lab sciences when size is above baseline
- To discourage oversize classes, escalates pay for each student over the baseline
 - \$2/day for 1 student,
 - \$4/day for 2 students,
 - \$10/day for 3 students,
 - \$18/day for 4 students. (4 students over the max requires an exemption to the max.)
- No teacher will have more than 3 classes at or above max class size unless mutually agreed upon

Fair and equitable funding for PE, library, & music: Establishes a resource fund that is distributed on a per-student basis- \$80,000 in 2023-24, \$100,000 in 2024-25, \$140,000 in 2025-26

Wages that keep pace with local inflation: Equivalent to 13% increase over the next 2 years

- 6.4% in 2023-24
- 6.6% in 2024-25
