Request a FREE set of LGBTQ+ affirming K-12 books!

GLSEN will be sending LGBTQ+ affirming text sets to over 2,400 schools in 31 states in the 2023–2024 school year. There are four grade-range options: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, or 9-12.

Founded in 2019, GLSEN's Rainbow Library Program has been featured in School Library Journal, District Administration Magazine, and has won a commendation award from the American Association of School Librarians.

LGBTQ+ students at schools with an LGBTQ+ inclusive curriculum, which includes LGBTQ+ affirming books, have higher GPAs, are less likely to hear anti-LGBTQ remarks at school, and are less likely to report missing school due to feeling unsafe.

Over 5,800 elementary, middle, and high schools have already received Rainbow Library sets, including in Washington State. Rainbow Library books are selected by a committee of experienced educators, librarians, and students. These texts are awardwinning, grade-aligned, and all received positive reviews from major literary journals. Resources are limited and will be prioritized in part on a first come, first served basis.

Don't walk away from loan forgiveness opportunities if you are confused about the programs and processes out there.

Many of you are likely eligible for federal student loan forgiveness through one or more of the federal programs currently available. There have been many program updates and changes in the past few years. NEA Member Benefits (NEA MB) has gathered the latest information as it applies to members and will share that information in three upcoming workshops.
