We learned about industrial pollution, commerce, displacement of native peoples, and the impact that 150 white settlers had in scuttling the proposed reservation along the shores of the river. Our tour guides admitted that they had never been on the river nor even thought about the waterway prior to attending Maritime High School, but now they see the significance of it and the need to continue the restoration. Thank you to Maritime educators Michael Stein-Ross and Jessie Traughber for the opportunity to participate. That evening, at the Seattle Kraken game, the One Roof Foundation announced a \$32,000 gift to Maritime High School in honor of the water taxi crew who heroically intervened and saved the Seattle waterfront from a break away cargo barge.
