### **In a School Board Minute**

#### What's happening at the school board meetings?

Periodically, we will provide information from the school board meetings that you may find interesting. It does not represent the opinion of LWEA or provide commentary on the topics. The first few installments will look at information gleaned from the January 8th Study Session on Budget planning.

#### **Enrollment**

- LWSD enrollment has decreased by approximately 500 students since pre-pandemic levels. This is a 1.6% reduction in enrollment.
- This decrease is low compared to the neighboring school districts but still significant. The loss in enrollment is at the elementary level with a decline of almost 10% since the pandemic. Middle schools have remained relatively level with a 1% increase and high schools have increased almost 12% since the pandemic.
- Future projections forecast that enrollment will continue to decline each year over the next 5 years before it begins to level out and increase slightly. The decrease in students over the next 5 years is projected to be a decline of .7% per year or 850 students. A strong factor in declining enrollment is the falling birth rate since 2016. This is not just a local issue, but a nationwide phenomenon.

# Are You Ready for Inclement Weather?

When emergency conditions such as snow and ice or windstorms result in school schedule changes, the district will notify staff directly through ParentSquare. This is an ideal time to make sure that you have updated your phone number with Human Resources to ensure that these calls go to the right number.

Here are some other ways to find out about school schedule changes:

- Pop-up alert on <a href="https://www.lwsd.org/">https://www.lwsd.org/</a> and school webpages.
- <u>Flashalert.net</u> This website allows you to sign up for text messages as well.

Local TV/radio stations – They get a feed from Flashalert.net of all school schedule change decisions.

Emergency late starts and closures change the responsibilities of LWEA members:

- In the event of a late start, staff are expected to report 1 hour before the new start time.
- Staff reporting to work when school closures are announced late (after 5:30 am for secondary and after 6:30 am for elementary) will be compensated.
- When emergency schedule changes occur, scheduled leaves will be processed as previously requested.
- Staff who are unable to report to work may request emergency leave or use annual leave.


