This edition is all about bargaining! Earlier in the week you received <u>your bargaining survey</u>. Please take the ten to fifteen minutes to complete the survey. We added three open ended questions at the end of the survey for you to add your thoughts. Two of the questions have specific prompts. One is there for you to add something that you think is important, because it's missing from the survey, or because you think it's significant and want to expand on it. Your bargaining team thanks you for your time. The survey closes on March 15th.

Yesterday we held our first joint bargaining session. The twenty of us in the room spent the early portion building community, the middle section digging into the particulars of bargaining the Highline Way, and then we got to work. We reached a tentative agreement on the 2024-25 calendar, with the exception of job-alike dates, which will be added later in bargaining. Once the color coding has been added and we've done a final check that it looks correct, it will be posted on the HSD website as a "tentative" calendar, since it could change during subsequent negotiations and will not be finalized until the new contract is ratified. Once that tentative calendar is ready for posting, we will link it in a future edition of the e-Focus.
